Orders made for 18 months Provide details of the progress and/or delay in the making of the permanent Order to replace the temporary order Boxted Bridge was closed due to safety concerns in June 2023 following the findings of a Principal Inspection. A planning application for the replacement of the Bridge was applied in December 2021. The replacement of the structure was dictated by the loading and highway alignment requirements necessary for a new structure compliant to standards. Consultations have taken place since and additional work has been requested by the planning teams which has prolonged the process. The following tasks need to be undertaken prior to the replacement of the Bridge and the reopening of the road: Obtaining Planning application (anticipated leftover duration 6 months) Complete Detailed Design (anticipated duration 1 year) Undertake a Compulsory Purchase Order (CPO) for the land required (anticipated duration 2 years) Site works (anticipated duration 1 year) Based on the above it is proposed that the closure is extended to September 2029.
