I am still not convinced that the wording is quite right. I queried part of the description with you on Monday evening but thought as it was the end of the day I was being a bit thick.

Item 4. states

The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (De-Restriction) Order 2005 is hereby temporarily suspended insofar as it relates to A133 Little Clacton and Weeley Heath Bypass from its junction with B1033 at Colchester Road Roundabout south for a distance of approximately 60 metres. All other restrictions contained within the order shall remain in place.

To me, this implies that the derestriction is suspended only for the 60 metres south of the roundabout but surely the derestriction needs to be suspended for the full 1267m.

Is the derestriction south of the 60m covered by a separate Order?
